Brigham and Women's outpatient Addiction Recovery Program (ARP) at Brigham and Women's Faulkner Hospital provides a holistic and individualized approach to addiction treatment and recovery. The ARP treatment team consists of physicians with expertise in addictions and licensed social workers who promote the power of personal growth and value **your** recovery journey.

Treatment options include:

- In-person and virtual appointments for both individual and group-based therapy
- FDA-approved medications for alcohol, opioid and tobacco use disorder, including Suboxone (buprenorphine), injectable extended-release naltrexone (Vivitrol) and injectable extended-release buprenorphine (Sublocade)
- Dual-diagnosis treatment for expert management of psychiatric and substance use disorders
- Smartphone-based adjunct to treatment if eligible via insurance
