For all procedures except venograms and catheter removals, patients must be NPO past midnight and need a responsible adult to drive or accompany them home, as these procedures involve sedation and patients cannot operate vehicles themselves.

Morning medications, in particular blood pressure medications, should be taken with a sip of water.
